### SENSORY SKILLS & GROUP ACTIVITY

- Playdough: vegetables- children will make vegetables using playdough
- Stringing Vegetables- children will string the vegetable cutouts using lace.

### CONCEPT/ COGNITIVE SKILLS

#### EVS

- Introduction to Vegetables- through flashcards, PPT and vegetable toy
- Introduction to Community Helper: Vegetable vendor & Chef - through PPT and oral conversation
- Introduction to various vegetables: Onion, Potato, Brinjal, Carrot, Capsicum, Brinjal, Green peas, Brinjal & Cucumber – through PPT, videos, flashcards & toy vegetables.
- Activity Book: Circle all vegetables -page 16 – using crayon for circling
- Activity Book: Look at the vegetables and name them -page 15 – teacher will point at vegetables while naming them and children will repeat the same.
- Vegetable quiz- teacher will ask question and children will answer.

#### MATH

- Introduction to shape: triangle – teacher will explain by using flashcard, ppt & oral conversation
- Numeracy book page 8- trace and colour the shape triangle using crayon.
- Introduction to number 2- using slate, flashcards and counting objects
- Numeracy book page 6 and 7- trace the number 2
- Number writing book page 2- trace

#### ENGLISH

- Reinforce concept: Open & Close :- showing real objects
- Introduction to Sight word: Door and Window :- showing real objects
- Introduction to Curved Lines: Pattern book page 17, 18 & 19- children will trace curved lines using crayon.
- Reinforce letters A & B- using flash card, sound of letters
- Intro to letters C- with flashcards, story, sound of letter and slate teacher will teach the children.
- Literacy book page 6 & 7
- Letter writing book page 3- trace letter C
